commiserate (v)	to feel sorry for someone, something, or a situation; to feel pity; to get <b>together with</b> someone to feel sadness
committee (n)	a group of people who meet <b>together</b> to discuss a topic
communication (n)	the act of talking <b>with</b> someone and discussing something <b>together</b>
community (n)	a place where people live <b>together</b>
compare (v)	to put things <b>together</b> to see how they are the same
compatible (adj)	able to live <b>together</b> and get along; things that can go <b>together</b> without problems

contrast (v)	to look at different things to see how they are <b>opposites</b> or not related
counterbalance (n)	a weight used to balance an <b>opposite</b> weight
counterclockwise (adv)	in the direction that is <b>opposite</b> of the direction the hands on the clock move
counterexample (n)	an example used to support a claim or statement that is the <b>opposite</b> of another claim or statement
counterfeit (adj)	being the <b>opposite</b> of real; fake or artificial
counterintuitive (adj)	goes <b>against</b> your gut feeling or common sense
