What are we learning about?

Reading: We will continue to set up reading workshop and daily 5 literacy stations. We will be reading books and identifying the problem and solution (plot) and retelling what happened in sequential order.

Writing: We will be writing stories that have a problem and a solution. We will focus on what makes a good story and how to add punctuation to our stories.

Math: We will continue using 10 frames to count. We will begin talking about counting forwards and backwards on a number line, the amount of tens and ones in a number and we will look at graphs that count by 2's.

Science/Social Studies: We will finish our lessons on safety and health and complete an assessment on Wednesday. We will then begin learning about science tools and how we use them.
