In reading students will practice the traits of a good reader. We will focus on making connections. Making connections to text is something strategic readers do all the time. It is the essence of why we read.

The process of sharing a piece of writing orally at various stages of the writing process allows the ear, the eye, and the brain to work together to see the whole picture. There will be partner sharing at every step of the writing process.

Math / Science / Social Studies

In math students will distinguish between even and odd numbers.

Students are introduced to the systems of government and leaders of those systems. The study begins with the student and moves to the teacher as head of the classroom, then identifies the principal as head of the school, the mayor as head of the city, the governor as head of the state, and the president as head of the United States.
